### CRITERIA & APPLICATION FORM 2023

The Scholarships are available to full-time students who whakapapa to Te Arawa and who are enrolled at a New Zealand tertiary institute in a NZQA recognised course.

The characteristics sought are:

- **Te Arawatanga:** You will be an active contributor to your Te Arawa iwi and/or hapū and have their endorsement.
- **Te Ao Māori me te Ao Pākehā:** You will be capable, comfortable and skilled to walk in both worlds.
- **Te Reo me ōna tikanga Māori:** You will be confident in your identity and culture.

Preference will be given to those students who:

- are in their last year of study;
- have proven academic merit;
- can demonstrate commitment to Te Reo Māori me ōna Tikanga;
- can demonstrate commitment to Te Arawa iwi, hapū, whānau, marae;

The Scholarships are awarded annually and are for a one-year period.

Successful recipients will receive the Scholarship payment in the following instalments:

- 70% paid into your nominated bank account on the day the scholarship is awarded; and
- 30% paid into your nominated bank account upon provision of an acceptable six monthly Progress Report **OR** in the case of the Postgraduate Scholarship recipient undertaking by thesis only - a statement of progress from their Supervisor.

The scholarship is awarded on the basis that the information supplied is true and correct.

Geyser reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship if the information provided is incorrect.

If the recipient withdraws or transfers to another programme, the Scholarship is to be repaid in full to Geyser.

Geyser reserves the right to not award any scholarship if there are no eligible candidates.

Recipients and their families will be invited to attend a Geyser awards ceremony to be held between December and March. Recipients are required to attend the ceremony to receive their Scholarship.

Recipients must provide a six monthly progress report to Geyser no later than 31 July. The progress report must include a one page written 'statement of achievement' and semester one academic results. A template will be provided. Should Geyser require, the recipients must be willing to present their statement of achievement in person at a Te Arawa iwi forum to be advised.

The recipient of the Postgraduate Scholarship must provide one bound copy of their thesis to the Stafford Collection of the Rotorua Public Library.

The decision of Geyser is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
